


In January 2020, Fr Aloysious suffered a massive stroke while attending a Jesuit Refugee Service (JRS) international meeting in Washington DC. The stroke was so acute that he lost movement on the right side of his body. Initially he was hospitalised in Washington DC and subsequently moved to a Jesuit aftercare facility in New York, USA. He was brought back to Malaysia to recover at the end of 2021. He stayed with the Jesuit community in Petaling Jaya with full assisted care until his death.



Malaysian-born Aloysius came to JRS Australia from the Malaysia-Singapore Jesuit Region at the end of 2010. After running the Jesuit candidate program in his home country, Aloysious spent two years undertaking Arabic studies in Egypt. His theological studies took place in London and Oxford, and he stayed on in Oxford to pursue research in Islamic history and law. He has worked in the fields of interfaith dialogue, public policy, and Islam, and spent a year as a Woodstock visiting fellow at Georgetown University before coming to Australia. Aloysius joined JRS on 1 February 2011, living and sharing with the St Canice faith community here in Elizabeth Bay.
